

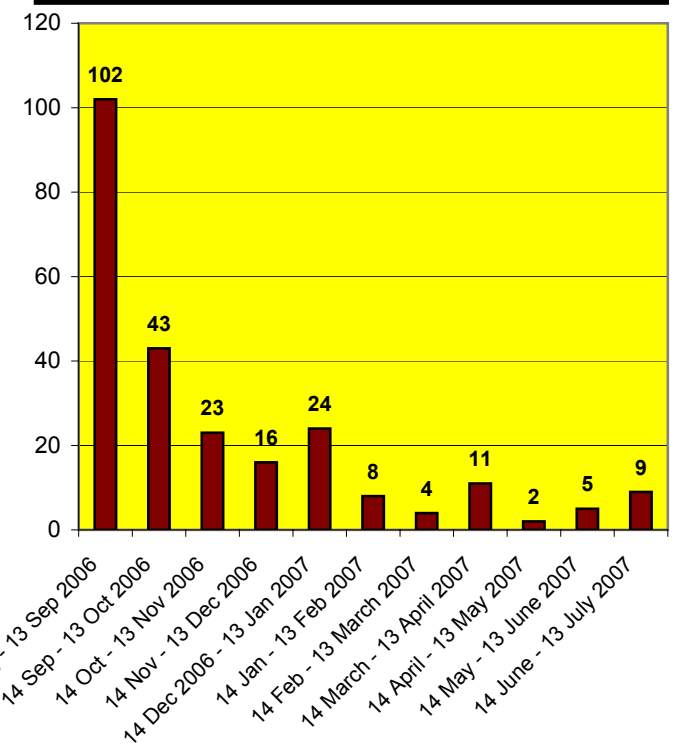
Information on Mine and UXO Victims
